B. Sacred Heart Polish Church, 927 Park Ave. First Mass held Aug. 20, 1892. Early members were Germans who lacked a church of their own and attended Mass at Assumption and St. Joseph's.

Plans for a new church, including 212-foot spires built with Gouverneur marble, were drawn in 1906. The cornerstone was laid Oct. 20, 1907.
