MR. ROOSEVELT THANKS PRIVATE EASTON FOR INSCRIPTION

**Gouverneur Boy With 302d Engineers
Put Inscription On Quentin Roosevelts Monument**

Mr. and Mrs. Edward Easton, of this village, have received a letter from their son, Leland G. Easton, of the 302nd Engineers, American Expeditionary Forces, in which he enclosed a certificate of recognition from the commanding officer for work done in lettering the Quentin Roosevelt monument, erected by the Engineers. The certificate reads, as follows: This is to certify that the stone which marks the grave of Lieutenant Quentin Roosevelt, in France was carved as described below, by Private Leland G. Easton, No. 1679086, Company A, 302nd Engineers: "On this Spot Fell Quentin Roosevelt, son of Ex-President Roosevelt July 14, 1918".
