

## LEWIS H. MITCHELL.

Gouverneur, Aug. 20.—Lewis H. Mitchell died at his home in Hailesboro yesterday morning. Mr. Mitchell was born in Gouverneur 76 years ago. He enlisted in the Sixteenth N. Y. Volunteer Cavalry. He re-enlisted in the field and was discharged June 9, 1865. At the organization of his company it consisted of 112 men. At the close of the war it consisted of 18 men. Of the original volunteers present to receive their discharge at the close of the war, but one remained. Mr. Mitchell was slightly wounded and had two horses shot from under him. Since the close of the war he had been a carriage painter. Mr. Mitchell is survived by three brothers, Leonard, of Antwerp; Calvin, of Dekalb, and Hiram, of Nova Scotia, besides his wife. The funeral will be held at the home in Hailesboro and interment will be in Riverside.
